Notice is hereby given that the Annual Meeting of Electors of the Town of Ledgeview may take action on any specific item listed within this agenda. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §60.11, no public notice of an annual town meeting is required if the annual town meeting takes place on the third Tuesday in April.

If the annual town meeting is not held on the third Tuesday in April, the meeting may be held within 10 days after the third Tuesday in April, but the notice must be published not more than 20 nor less than 15 days prior to the date of the annual meeting. See sections §60.11(2)(b), §60.11(4) and §60.12(3) of the Wis. Stats.
