

**ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS MINUTES**

**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Town Board Chairman Phil Danen at 6:00 p.m.

**2. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

1. Approval of April 20, 2021 Annual Meeting Minutes.

**Motion made by** Jan Schmidt - to approve the minutes, **seconded by** Dan Kerkhoff – 3848 Dickinson. No further discussion. Motion carried in a voice vote.

**3. PRESENTATION AND ACTION ON ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIALS.**

Staff went over the annual report and financials.

Resident Jan Schmidt asked about the revenue of the Golf Course. Staff advised we do not own the course, but only the property itself.

**Motion made by** Jan Schmidt to accept the Annual Report and Financials as written, **seconded by** Ken Geurts. No further discussion. Motion carried in a voice vote.

**4. DISCUSS AND ACT ON CONTRIBUTION TO THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND.**

Recommendation by Public Works Director, Greg Potts, is that no additional funds are requested. No specific bridge aide is needed for the storm water fund balance in sanitary budget currently.

**Motion made by** Dan Kerkhoff to put zero (\$0.00) funds in to the County Bridge Fund. **Motion seconded by** Jan Schmidt.

**5. PUBLIC INPUT AND ACTION.**

**Jan Schmidt – 4500 Rockland:**

Has a problem with all of the signs that keeps going up, the Ledgeview signs at the round-a-bout, and the repetitive bike signs. Stated he also was having a hard time accessing the minutes on our website.

Staff advised the recommendation for some of these signs as it was towards our branding.

**Luann Pansier – 3701 Dickinson Road:**

Questions regarding the parking at Scray Hill Park and getting additional parking.

Staff advised it is on the CIP plan for 2025. It has to be that far out due to bonding and borrowing of monies. The plan is to add approximately ninety (90) spaces in the southern portion of the current parking lot going towards Scray Hill Road.

**Dan Kerkhoff – 3848 Dickinson Road:**

Concerned about the parking at Scray Hill Park's parking, and people parking in the area where the Town gets our water from.

Staff advised there are temporary signs that will be put up to help with this issue.

**Jan Schmidt – 4500 Rockledge Court:**

Why when jobs are posted is it called a roll, when rolls are for acting.

**Luann Pansier – 3701 Dickinson Road:**

Asked if there was any update on the Southern Bridge

Staff advised this past week Senator Baldwin awarded via the Build Back Better \$5,000,000 in funds for planning of bridge.

First up is a lane expansion by adding a lane / exit off of I-41. As it stands now, it is all being built from west to east. Anticipate the earliest anything would come on the east side of the river is ten years. Southern Bridge Road will go from Rockland Road to Red Maple.
